Course information

Level of classes	Course Content	
Novice-High Level	The Novice-High Level course is for beginner Chinese learners. Teachers teach directly in Chinese online. Depending on the situation of the student, both Mandarin Phonetic Symbols and Pinyin pronunciation symbols are used. The emphasis is on teaching students the basic pronunciation, grammar and common vocabulary to achieve the purpose of using basic Chinese language to communicate.	
Intermediate-Low Level	The Intermediate-Low Level course is designed for students who have previously studied at least one academic year of Mandarin Chinese and have already achieved basic, intermediate Chinese communication skills. The course aims to help students acquire colloquial usages and conversational skills so they can narrate their own views or introduce things and begin to interact with people.	
Intermediate-Mid Level	The Intermediate-Mid Level course is designed for students who have previously studied at least one and a half academic years of Mandarin Chinese and have already achieved a significant amount of intermediate Chinese communication skills. The course aims to help students acquire colloquial usages and conversational skills so they can take part in informal conversations in an interactive manner.	
Intermediate-High Level	This course is designed for students who have previously studied at least two academic years of Mandarin Chinese and who already possess the ability to verbally describe events, present ideas, and interact with others fluently. The course aims to help students develop communication skills for various social and academic purposes. Students are expected to learn to interact with others in more formal contexts with the appropriate style, tone, and usage.	
Advanced Level	This course is designed for students who have previously studied at least three academic years of Mandarin Chinese and who already possess the ability to communicate with others in various contexts fluently. The course aims to help students develop communication skills for a wide range of social purposes.	

Course policy and certificate

1. The following technology and equipment are required for all students of the virtual program:	 A laptop/desktop/tablet computer. A smart phone alone will not be adequate for the online course. Video and audio devices to transmit images and sound; A headset with a microphone is highly recommended. A valid email address and possibly other social media Emails addresses are used for regular communication with the students and for setting up accounts for Moodle. 	
2. Class rules	 Use Chinese for all classes, individual language practice sessions. Follow the dress-code of a regular class in your university whenever appearing online. Find an appropriate and quiet place for all class sessions Submit homework on time or penalties for late submission will apply. Turn on your video when entering the virtual classroom. Request and receive your teacher's permission before sharing your screen in class. Every group class session will be recorded. These recordings will be available for review after class. 	
3. Certificate	Students who attend the class according to the rules and complete the course requirement will be given a certificate of attendance of the virtual program.
